1. Welcome and apologies.

 Meeting chaired by Wendy Skinner Smith. Reps from 21 sites and OCC Parks were thanked for attending.

2. Minutes of the last ALM

- The minutes of last ALM held 30 January 2018 had been circulated [late] and were agreed as an accurate record. Minutes have been on the website but were only emailed out today apologies for this.
- Corrections Sharon Murray (South Ward) and Jon Piggott (Lenthall Road) attended but had been missed off the sign-in sheet NJ to correct.
- Mary Cooper was organising a RHS visit rather than a talk as stated in the minutes

3. Oxford City Council Reactive maintenance budget 2017-2018 update

- 2017-18 budget has all been spent. Grant applicants should have have heard back by now.
- Rather than losing it at the end of the financial year, the amount remaining after grants were made was allocated to ODFAA for the 2019 Centenary.
- Brasenose fencing application had been declined. Brasenose issues including maintenance work
 done by volunteers to be discussed with SF.

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- c. £500,000 spent on fencing allotments over the last decade.
- It will be essential going forward that Associations consider developing Site Asset Management Plans. WE need to ensure the new OCC leases are realistic with regard to covering costs.

4. Focus for next OCC Allotment Grant round 2018-2019

- Forms should be sent out from OCC before the end of May.
- Focus on composting, water harvesting and solar power focussing on sustainability; building & site security; accessibility.

 Phil is exploring publishing costs and print runs to see if we need.

- Four Draft one-pagers received already (Elder Stubs, Cow Mead, Cripley Meadow and South Ward)
